Eligibility

To be eligible for the Centerville-Washington History Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior whose primary residence is in Centerville or Washington Township
- Be accepted at/planning to attend, a two- or four-year accredited public or private college/university
- Plans should include a major or minor in History or Education; or have volunteered a minimum of 6 hours as a Teen Volunteer with Centerville-Washington History
- Monies must be used for undergraduate school expenses

- 500-word essay
- Parent and Student Signatures

No late applications will be considered.**
